


Nominations: Now Open for NSCMHF 2020 Inductees

Nominations for potential Nova Scotia Country Music Hall of Fame inductees opened on October 1 and will remain open until February 15, 2020.

Anyone may nominate an individual in a particular category as described in the nomination forms on the NSCMHF website. If you consider nominating someone, you are urged to read the nomination forms on the NSCMHF website carefully.

Anyone who nominates a person for this honour, is reminded that all information required on the form must be filled out. Inductions are based on the body of work that has been done by a nominee in categories stated on the nomination form. Multiple nominations for a particular individual bear no more weight than a single nomination describing the nominee's body of work in precise detail.

Names of successful nominees will be announced in the spring of 2020.
